All guests must proceed directly to Dyess Lanes using the most direct route of travel (Arnold Blvd, 4th Street, Avenue C). No one will be authorized to drive or to stop at any other location under this agreement. We ask that no photos be taken while visiting the Dyess Lanes. All authorized guests are allowed to stop at the Pro Shop. Upon completion of bowling everyone should exit Dyess AFB using the same route of travel. All civilians are subject to other rule and regulations that govern the Base. (See page 2)

VISITING DYESS AFB

Civilians are subject to adhere to base posted traffic regulations, and state/federal laws while visiting Dyess AFB. The Dyess AFB Security Forces may stop individuals not following the posted traffic regulations. The following is a non-exhaustive list of particulars that civilians are expected to adhere to while visiting Dyess AFB:

- Observance of the National Anthem: The national anthem is played daily at 1700 hours. Traffic flow (including golf carts) will stop until the national anthem is complete. Individuals outside of their vehicles (golfers included) will pause from their activity and face the direction of the flag or music until the national anthem is complete.

- Drinking and Driving: State drinking and driving laws apply on Dyess AFB. Base Security Forces will detain drivers until the Abilene Police Department arrives.

- Business Activities: Dyess Lanes Guests may not use the 7th Force Support facilities to make or repair items for personal gain. They may not distribute merchandise purchased at a 7th Force Support activity (i.e. Dyess Lanes Pro Shop) to unauthorized persons. They may not personally profit from the use of 7th Force Support merchandise or services or stolen merchandise.

- Bad Checks: Presenting bad checks intentionally or repeatedly or failing to make restitution on the indebtedness is grounds for termination.
