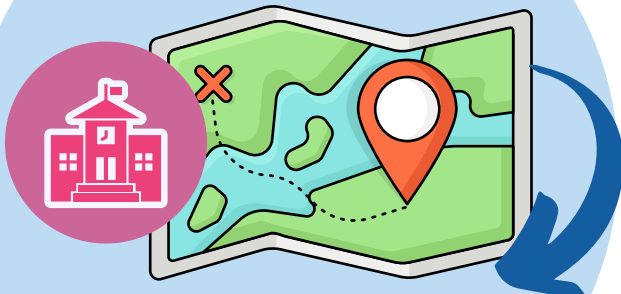


MAP OF SCHOOLS AROUND DYESS AFB

Student2Student



Student to Student (S2S) is a student-led, faculty-advised program with the mission to take care of new students. Each Purple Star School implements this transition program. Ask your campus counselor about it during enrollment.

WHAT WE DO

School Liaisons are installation subject matter experts to families, installation leadership staff, and commanders who assist with all local Pre-K-12 school issues and challenges facing military children.
